Difficulty was encountered during construction of the stadium, however, as the in-situ clayey material would not support the combined load of the enormous Skywalk beam and the crane being used to erect it. With the project facing an emergency, Global Civils, a contractor which has been utilizing AnyWay's products in various South African and Namibian projects, was called in to assist by stabilizing the in-situ material with our cementitious soil stabilizer ANSS. This created a stable platform strong enough to support the massive load, permitting the Skywalk to be hoisted into place. AnyWay's ability to rapidly produce durable pavement and hardstand areas through soil stabilization facilitated the timely completion of this great project.
